Responsibilities:

- Report directly to the Food Services Supervisor
- Place the health, safety, and wellness of our members above all else
- Assist in preparing and serving meals, including breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks for 200+ people
- Maintain cleanliness and sanitation of the kitchen area in accordance with Department of Health standards
- Assist with inventory management and food storage
- Support meal prep, cooking, and cleanup as needed
- Adapt to changing schedules and locations while on tour
- Perform other responsibilities as assigned

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years or older
- No prior experience required—willingness to learn and work hard is essential
- Experience in food service or a kitchen setting is a plus but not required
- Comfortable working in a fast-paced, team-oriented environment
- Able to lift and carry supplies (up to 50 lbs)
- Must maintain professionalism and adhere to all staff regulations
- Must maintain a professional separation from the corps membership, even if they are of marching age
- Romantic relationships with members are strictly prohibited
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Open to ongoing training and willing to adapt to Troopers rules, policies, and procedures
- Accountable and open to feedback from program administration
